Don't turn a blind eye: Every day lives are lost at work

WHO (World Health Organization) estimates that 2.1% of all deaths and 2.7% of the disease worldwide can be attributed to occupational risks. Thus, actions towards healthier and safer workplaces will contribute to improve and protect the lives of millions around the world.







According to ILO (International Labour Organization) estimates, nearly 3 million workers die every year due to work-related accidents and diseases, an increase of more than 5 per cent compared to 2015 Most of these work-related fatalities, totaling 2.6 million deaths, stem from work-related diseases. Work accidents account for an additional 330,000 deaths, according to the analysis.

Almost 4% of the world's annual GDP is lost due to incidents which could have been prevented.

The construction industry has a higher than average rate of accidents.

Younger and older workers are particularly vulnerable.









Prevention is not a cost, but an investment. It pays off.

According to the research project by the International Social Security Association (ISSA), the German Social Accident Insurance (DGUV) and the German Social Accident Insurance Institution for the energy, textile, electrical and media products sectors (BG **ETEM)** spending on occupational safety and health is an investment that "pays off".

The Return on Prevention (ROP) is assessed to be 2.2.
















The Vision Zero Journey
