



and health promotion. By promoting a culture of healthy, sustainable business, we aim to create a positive impact on communities and societies worldwide.


JIOSH+W 2025 is an annual event, continuing beyond 2025 to champion safety, health, and well-being in workplaces everywhere.

A new approach called "Collaborative Safety," which aims to enhance both safety and productivity by integrating humans, machines, and the environment through ICT technology, is gaining significant attention. This concept was first introduced to the world in 2017 through IEC ACOS and has since been the subject of active discussions. In 2025, the year of the Osaka Expo, the international standard on collaborative safety, IEC Guide 127, is expected to be published. This guide will be issued as an international standard to ensure safety, health, and well-being in future working environments. The possibility of holding an international symposium session on the topic is being considered.




